This meeting is also to be dedicated to the discussion on student participation in governance and management at the State University of Novi Pazar. Management of the State University of Novi Pazar, Prof. Dolicanin and Prof. Jovanovic, presented organization structure of the University, role of Students parliament and ways of students participation in governance and management. Student representatives, Ms. Kurtanovic and Mr. Halilovic, explained their experience with student participation at the State University of Novi Pazar.

Representatives of National team, Prof. Stankovic and Mr. Jovic, explained that the Working group, the National team of policy makers was created gathering representatives of students, MoE, NCHE in order to develop a proposal for a new legislation on student participation in university governance and management, based on the results of analysis and conclusions regarding the new legislation on student participation. Representatives of the State University of Novi Pazar had given some significant suggestions for proposal of a new legislation on student organizing.
